Typical duties of a faculty member include hospital and ICU medicine, private patient duties, precepting, lecturing, scholarly activities and curriculum management.

There are currently five full-time faculty members plus one psychologist. The program has been in operation for 13 years producing 66 family practice physicians and boasts a 50% retention rate of graduating residents practicing in our service area.
